
















WELCOME!

He is an Honorary Lecturer at the University of East Anglia, Director of Advanced Paediatric Life Support courses, Director of Surgical Skills courses from the Royal College of Surgeons, Faculty for European Paediatric Advanced Life Support Courses and an executive member of the Education Committee of the European Society of Paediatric Endoscopic Surgeons. His subspeciality interests are neonatal surgery, thoracic and upper gastro intestinal paediatric surgery.



Dr Sarah M. Jeelani

Dr Sarah M. Jeelani is a Year 1 Core Surgical Trainee in the Norfolk and Norwich University Hospital NHS Trust, located in the East of England Deanery. Her early medical career began with completing by MBBS (Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery) from the Aga Khan University in Karachi, Pakistan. Afterwards, she gained further foundation training in the UK and became interested in the surgical speciality of Paediatric Surgery. Her other non-clinical interest lies in medical education for undergraduate medical students and global health economics. She also holds a PG Cert in Medical Education for the University of Warwick. Her lecture on Acute & Chronic Pancreatic Cancer aims to help medical students in clinical years to understand the pathophysiology of pancreatitis as a disease process.

Dr. Dev graduated from Palacky University, Faculty of Medicine, Czechia in 2021. During university, he was elected President of their Student Union (PEPA), and was also the UIMS Vice-President until 2022. Currently, he is working as a FY2 Doctor in the North-West of England. Dr. Dev has a keen career interest in Emergency Medicine, as well as venturing into Expedition/Wilderness medicine alongside it. He has completed a Mountain Medicine course in Scotland and is also a certified PADI scuba-diver, in which he plans to complete the Rescue Diver certification in the near future. He has also completed his Advanced Life Support course (ALS), which is essential for any expedition or doctor in the acute field. His talk will give you a key insight into the diverse world of Expedition/Wilderness Medicine, some of the acute conditions involved and how you can begin your pathway as a student and doctor.



MuDr. Shawn Britto

MuDr. Shawn Britto is a FY2 Doctor currently working at University Hospital, Plymouth NHS Trust in Oncology. He is a proud alumni of Charles University, 1st Faculty of Medicine who is keen to share the knowledge he has gained during the transition from a medical student in Prague to Junior Doctor in the NHS via his lecture and workshop today. MuDr. Britto's lecture will focus on recognising early signs of ACS, differentiating between the types of ACS and rationalizing treatment and escalation. The aim of this lecture is to learn the nuance of managing ACS as an SHO on a ward rather than as a Cardiology specialist as more often than not you will be the first line of call in diagnosis and early stabilization of patients with ACS.

The workshop includes basic instruments, suture types and selection, wound assessment, local anaesthesia, aftercare, and documentation.



INTERPRETATION OF A CXR: A JUNIOR DOCTOR'S PERSPECTIVE Dr Shawn Britto

This workshop will focus on the basics of interpreting CXRs. As a junior doctor, you will come across CXRs quite often and being able to accurately interpret a CXR will tremendously help with your diagnostic approach.

In this workshop we will cover the A-E approach of interpreting CXRs and common presentations you will encounter as a junior doctor.


